2	Entering the cab of a vehicle which has just been returned to the depot to check the mileage and return condition. The virus can survive on untreated surfaces for some time. Traces of the virus could be left in the cab if the driver is infected and these could be picked up on entering the cab and coming into contact with surfaces touched by the driver – steering wheel, door handles, controls etc.	Office based staff receiving the vehicle on return to the depot and their immediate family.	Maintain social distancing whenever you come into contact with the customer. The cab door or doors can be opened for a few minutes in order to adequately vent before you enter. Use disposable gloves when working inside the vehicle and coming into contact with the internal surfaces – steering wheel, levers, door handles etc. which the driver could have touched. On completing the job carefully remove the disposable gloves, put them in the bin provided and thoroughly wash your hands using the facilities available. If you develop any symptoms – report them immediately to your line manager, refrain		



			from working and self-isolate.		
3	Valeting the returned vehicle – as above, where employees – Falcon Vehicle Solutions – could come into contact with surfaces contaminated with the virus whilst cleaning the returned vehicle	Valeting employees – Falcon Vehicle Solutions and their immediate family. Valeting operations are sub contracted – DGC & CTR.	Use the PPE provided – overalls, face mask, disposable gloves and safety glasses. Carefully remove the gloves on completion of the work, dispose of them in the bins provided and thoroughly wash your hands. The vehicle should be thoroughly cleaned before it is released to the workshop for further work.
